

#### PL RADOM04

-Application documents received after application deadlines will not be accepted;

-Application forms and Learning Agreements should be filled in English in capital letters with correct address of University and correct name of responsible Erasmus coordinator;

-Student should send Application Form, Learning Agreements in 3 copies- signed and stamped by Erasmus coordinators with 3 photos to address: Wyższa Szkoła Handlowa, ul. Traugutta 61a, 26- 600 Radom, Poland;

-Students should hold insurance card.

1. Applications/information on nominated students must reach the receiving institution by:

2. The receiving institution will send its decision within six weeks.

3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than five weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.

4. Termination of the agreement

The agreement will become operative on the date of signature of both universities and shall remain in force for a period of **6 years**. In case of the termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be sent to the partner university. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

#### Failing Grades:

- 1) F1: is given to students who do not fulfill the requirements for attendance, and who do not have right to take the final or makeup examination, coefficient is zero.
- 2) F2: is given to students who attend the classes regularly, but do not take the final or makeup examinations, coefficient is zero.
- 3) F3: is given to students who attend the classes regularly, take the final or makeup examinations, but whose percentage of the exam is below 50 or whose percentage of final grade is below 60, coefficient is zero. It is also given to students who do not have right to take final or makeup examinations due to their inefficiency of practice.
- 4) K: is given to students who fail the course. It is for non-credit courses
- 5) G: Pass (Out of Grade)
