**F1**: it is given to students who do not fulfil the requirements for attendance, and who do not have right to take the final or makeup examination, and thus its coefficient is zero.

F2: it is given to students who attend the classes regularly, but do not take the final or makeup examinations; its coefficient is zero.

**F3**: it is given to students, who attend the classes regularly, take the final or makeup examinations, but whose percentage of the exam is below 50 or whose percentage of final grade is below 60; its coefficient is zero. It is also given to students who do not have right to take final or makeup examinations due to their inefficiency of practice.

K/E: it is given to students who fail the course. It is for non-credit courses.
