



**PROTOCOL BETWEEN
KARABUK UNIVERSITY
(TURKEY)
AND
UNIVERSITÉ CHEIKH ANTA DIOP
(SENEGAL)**

Article 1

This protocol comprises the joint scientific work and educational and cultural collaboration between Karabuk University and Université Cheikh Anta Diop.

Article 2

This protocol has been composed with the main aims of encouraging the research and educational approaches of Karabuk University and Université Cheikh Anta Diop between the teaching staff, assistants, researchers, experts and students of both universities, developing existing relations, enabling the joint use of research work results and publishing these results, and transferring the experiences of the parties in educational approaches and in the joint scientific organizations.

Article 3

Both parties (Karabuk University and Université Cheikh Anta Diop) acknowledge undertake the following articles that make up the whole of this protocol and the terms of its application for the realization of these articles.

Article 4

Both parties will work in the fields they will collaborate with within the framework determined above and the criteria clearly determined below, and they will exchange scientific knowledge, technological know-how and experience. In this context:

Article 5

- a. Persons subject to academic exchange are teaching staff, research staff and experts.
- b. The main priorities of teaching staff, research staff and experts should be aimed at joint research, the development and transfer knowledge and organization of study meetings.
- c. The other party will be notified of the names proposed by the proposing party within reasonable time and the opinions of the other party concerning the candidate and its approval will be sent to the sending university at least two months in advance of the commencement of the scheduled visit.
- d. Each participant shall bear and be responsible for paying his or her own travel, housing expenses, meal costs, health insurance, and other miscellaneous fees. Upon request, the host institution agrees to use its best efforts to assist the teaching staff, research staff and experts in making advance arrangements for their accommodation.
- e. The visiting teaching staff, research staff and experts will benefit from all campus libraries and will take privilege of them in accordance to the host university library regulations.

Article 6

- a) Both universities will endeavor to provide exchange for students with a scientific approach. The number of students to benefit from the exchange process will be determined by a joint commission to be formed following the signing of the protocol by both parties based on mutual understanding. The host university will be notified of the names and fields of education of the students determined by the sending university at least three months beforehand and the host university will announce its decision regarding applications to the other party at least 1 month before the commencement of the academic year.
- b) Both universities will exempt visiting students from charges such as education and registration fees. The principal procedure requires that such charges are paid at the institution to which the student is attached to. All social payments other than education and registration fees will be met by students.
- c) Students - excluding tuition and registration fees - will be subject to the regulations of the host university. The sending university will accept the examinations of the

host university and their results.

- d) For application, students will present a document demonstrating his/her language proficiency meeting the terms and level required by the host university.
- e) Each participant will be responsible for his/her travel expenses and expenses incurred from travel documents. Upon request, the host institution will assist the visiting student for suitable accommodation. Accommodation costs will not exceed the prices paid by native students. Visiting students will also have the right to benefit from all the privileges of the campus (e.g. the use of libraries, student canteens and social facilities etc.) that native students have and at the same prices.
- f) Each participant should obtain a health and accident insurance against any medical problems or accidents that may be faced during their exchange period in their own country prior to their travel. The insurance company and the limit of the insurance should be valid in the host country.
- g) Necessary procedures will be implemented for the recognition of awards, certificates and documents of attendance awarded to the visiting student for participating to seminars, courses, etc. during his/her stay at the host university.

Article 7

After having been approved by official governmental authorities this protocol will be considered valid for five (5) years once signed by the appropriate officials of each university. Three months before the end of the protocol duration, the conditions of the protocol will be reviewed. Accordingly, the protocol will be extended for another five years or will be cancelled. Requests for withdrawal from the protocol must be in writing. This notification must be given at least one (1) year prior to the termination of the five (5) year program.

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR ACADEMIC
COLLABORATION**

BETWEEN

KARABUK UNIVERSITY TURKEY

Represented by Rector, Prof. Dr. Refik POLAT

AND

CHEIKH ANTA DIOP UNIVERSITY, SENEGAL

Represented by Rector, Prof. Dr. Ahmadou Aly Mbaye

The following decisions have been taken between KARABÜK UNIVERSITY and CHEIKH ANTA DIOP UNIVERSITY, regarding student admission to KARABÜK UNIVERSITY.

- 1- 250 students will be accepted to Karabuk University at associate and undergraduate levels.
- 2- Among the students who graduated from high school in Senegal and applied to the Senegal Scholarship Directorate for the scholarship program for Karabük University, the first 250 students will be evaluated by Karabük University according to their score order.
- 3- Students aged under 25 will be accepted to Karabuk University,
- 4- 5 Senegalese students will be admitted to the Faculty of Medicine and 5 to the Faculty of Dentistry, and the tuition fee of these students will be 1000 dollars annually.
- 5- 200 dollars will be charged to the students who are placed in other departments except for Medicine and

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Dentistry.

- 6- Senegalese students studying at Karabuk University will meet their own accommodation and living expenses,
- 7- Students will pay \$ 300 to TÖMER for the Turkish language course.
- 8- Karabuk University can accept 50 master and doctorate students to different departments,
- 9- The fee for master's degree is 1500 dollars and the doctorate fee is 3000 dollars.
- 10- Students who have completed 2 years associate degree in Senegal can apply to a bachelor's degree to get a bachelor's degree diploma at Karabuk University in 3 years after completing 1 year in TÖMER.
- 11- Students who start Karabük University until the end of January 2021, can start their TÖMER education and also start their formal education in the 2021-2022 academic year without any year loss.
- 12- 20 students who with a high score of A + and chosen by the Senegal Ministry of Higher Education will be given 100 dollars scholarship monthly by Karabük University.

Principles

All participants will be treated in the same non-discriminatory manner in carrying out the provisions of the Agreement, subject to the provisions of the policies and requirements of each of the institutions.

Terms of Cooperation

Duration

This Agreement shall commence on the later of the two dates of signature of the parties, this being the date when both parties have duly accepted the conditions laid down in this Agreement. The Agreement shall be in force for **three (3) years** and may be renewed or extended by mutual written consent of the authorized officials of the parties to it.

Amendments

Any amendment and/or modification of the Agreement will require written approval of both Parties and shall be appended hereto.

Termination for convenience

Either Party reserves the right to terminate this Agreement at any time, for any or no reason, subject to **six (6) months** prior written notice to the other party hereto. Any program or activity that has



already commenced pursuant to specific cooperation agreements executed between the parties hereto, if executed, shall survive termination of this Agreement and be completed to the best of both parties' abilities pursuant and subject to the terms of the relevant specific cooperation agreement.

This Agreement is drafted in 2 original copies in English, with identical content.
