





# ERASMUS+ KA171 PROJECT 2023-2024 ACADEMIC YEAR ANNOUNCEMENT OF STAFF TEACHING MOBILITY (Grant Agreement: 2023-1-TR01-KA171-HED-000162509)

A joint project will be carried out in the field of Digitalization with **Amadou Mahtar MBOW University, West Africa** within the scope of the Erasmus+ KA171 project. Within the scope of the project, **8 Academic Staff Mobilities** are expected to be realized in the 2023-2024 academic year in line with the criteria stated below. To comply with the project content, only Academic Staff from Computer Engineering, KBUZEM and Software Engineering departments are expected to apply. Depending on the status of the applications, it is planned to select 4 Academic Staff from the Computer Engineering Department, 2 Academic Staff from KBUZEM and 2 Academic Staff from the Software Engineering Department.

The assignment of Academic Staff to participate in the project is limited to 5 days, excluding travel days. In Staff Teaching Mobility, at least 8 hours of teaching are required for 5-day mobility. Travel expenses will be calculated and paid using the Beneficiary Module distance calculator.

## **Staff Teaching Mobility**

Staff teaching mobility: A staff member who is obliged to teach at a higher education institution holding an ECHE in Turkiye, a higher education institution in a Partner Country, or a staff member obliged to teach at a higher education institution in a Partner Country is allowed to teach students and give lectures at a higher education institution holding an ECHE in Turkiye. It is a field of activity that allows the institution to carry out academic/educational activities jointly with the other institution in relation to providing education.

### The staff who will participate in the activity must meet the following minimum criterias:

### **Application Criterias for Staff Teaching Mobility**

- 1. Being at least a part-time lecturer in Karabük University at Computer Engineering Department, KBUZEM or Software Engineering Department
- 2. Academic Staff must complete their mobility by June 30, 2024.

3. Having at least 60 points from any of the language exams specified- Foreign language exams (YDS/YÖKDİL/KPDS/ÜDS) organized by ÖSYM or Foreign Language Exams specified in ÖSYM's International Foreign Language Exams Equivalence Document (CPE, CAE, TOEFL iBT and PTE).

- The staff's activity periods (7 days) will be fully funded.

#### **Application Procedures**

The announcement process for the KA 171 Staff Teaching Mobility held between West Africa, Senegal Amadou Mahtar MBOW University and Karabuk University, Turkiye is between 18 December 2023 and 8 January 2024, and the application process is between 9 January and 23 January 2024. Applications will be taken online through the link <u>https://turnaportal.ua.gov.tr/giris?returnUrl=%2F</u>. Applications will be evaluated by the Exchange Programs, Staff and Student Mobility Selection Commission.

When applying, the mandatory fields specified in the system must be filled in and documents must be uploaded.
