



**Memorandum of Understanding for Joint Scientific and Academic
Cooperation between
Zarqa University in the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan
And
Karabuk University in the State of Turkiye**

Parties to the Agreement:

The First Party: Zarqa University, represented by the president of the university, Prof. Nidhal Al-Ramahi, or whomever he authorizes in writing to do so, and its address is the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan - Zarqa.

The Second Party: Karabuk University, represented for the purposes of this agreement by the president of the university, Prof. Dr. Refik Polat, or whomever he authorizes in writing or on his behalf to do so, and its address is the State of Turkiye - Karabuk.

Preamble:

In embodiment of the principle of joint cooperation between the two parties, and in order to strengthen the mutual relationship between them, they are willing to cooperate in various scientific and academic affairs, as an embodiment of the national trend towards encouraging holding joint and hosted programs at different levels, networking, and exchanging experiences between educational institutions in the world, they agree to the following:

Article One - The Preamble to this memorandum is considered an integral part of it and is read with it for all purposes.

Article Two - This memorandum seeks to set the objectives and means of scientific and academic cooperation between the two contracting parties.

Article Three - The two parties shall work to develop prospects for cooperation and exchange between them, whether it is related to the exchange of the faculty, the exchange of student scholarships, or the implementation of joint scientific programs.

Article Four - The two parties agreed to enhance aspects of cooperation of common interest in the following academic aspects, and to be in accordance with the capabilities available to both parties:

- a. Exchange visits of professors, faculty members, and researchers.
- b. Enhancing academic cooperation in community service, continued education, and other training programs.
- c. Developing the capabilities of faculty members.
- d. D. Student exchange.
- e. Enhancing cooperation in research materials and projects.
- f. Organizing academic meetings, conferences, scientific and technical research, seminars, training courses, and other joint activities between the two parties.
- g. Exchange of knowledge sources, education, e-learning, and digital scientific materials.
- h. Cooperation in the development of academic programs, plans, curricula, and courses.
- i. Cooperation in the establishment of cultural and sports weeks and other various activities between the two institutions.
- j. Encouragement to benefit from scientific and academic expertise between the two institutions.
- k. Cooperation in the field of holding joint and hosted programs in postgraduate studies for different disciplines.
- l. Cooperation in the formation of examination committees for theses and dissertations (postgraduate studies between the two sides).
- m. Cooperation in the arbitration of articles published in scientific journals between the two universities.



Article Five - The two parties work to organize separate agreements for each of the activities mentioned in Article Four of this memorandum, in which the details of cooperation in that activity and the rights and obligations of both parties are mentioned.

Article Six - The two parties agreed that any amendment to the basis of cooperation stipulated in this memorandum shall be made through the exchange of official correspondence that is considered an integral part of it.

Article Seven - The signing of this memorandum does not entail any financial obligations on either party.

Article Eight – This memorandum is organized into eight articles, including this article, in two copies in Arabic, in the hands of each party, a copy, in writing on today 12.09.2022 corresponding to/1/2022.
